### **Inmate Walks Off Work Detail**

An inmate of the Chatham County Jail walked off from a work detail at the Chatham County Courthouse on Montgomery Street this afternoon. Inmate Grady Haggray was checked out from the Jail by the Courthouse maintenance staff for grounds keeping at the Courthouse this morning. Around 2:30 this afternoon, our Courthouse personnel were notified by Maintenance personnel that they were unable to locate Mr. Haggray.

Our staff conducted an exterior and interior search of the Courthouse grounds and was unable to locate him. Deputies are currently in the process of searching the immediate area and known areas that Grady Haggray frequented before his incarceration.

Inmate Haggray is a nonviolent offender that is currently serving time for a technical violation of Probation. Mr. Haggray violated his probation by failing to report and owing \$230 in probation fees. He is currently listed as an inmate in the inmate worker program. His prior arrest charges are burglary in 1985 and Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Marijuana with intent to distribute in 1987. He was currently on probation for the burglary offense.

Mr. Haggray is a 42 year old black male and is listed as 5'09" and weighs 150 pounds. Attached is a photo of Mr. Haggray.
